- 1. Today we see what Paul meant when that power is denied Rom 1:20-25
- 2. Paul battled the mindset of Paganism in his day
 - a. Established by a scholarly wing of thought
 - b. Rejects Christianity as "foolish"
- 3. Paul very well could be describing the modern evolutionary movement
 - a. The great imaginations
 - b. They claim that only they have knowledge

c. They changed the Glory of God in His creation to that of evolutionary descent, instead of man from God, man came from animals

- d. They worship and serve the god Evolution
 - (1) With a Faith that sometimes exceeds our own

<u>The Meaning of Evolution</u>, by G.G. Simpson: "Man is the result of a purposeless and materialistic process that did not have him in mind." Darwin pointed out that no supernatural designer was needed; since natural selection could account for any known form of life, there was no room for a supernatural agency in its evolution."

C. It was grown by deceit

1. The Scopes trial in Tennessee in 1925

2. If you saw the movie Inherit The Wind, you understand the story of evolution today

a. No, not as the movie pronounced it, but the lie that is passed on as truth

- b. The movie is a lie as the idea of "evolutionary science" is a lie; it is evil hidden
- as innocent truth

3. The lies of the movie -

a. It was not an innocent, victimized teacher

We are looking for a Tennessee teacher who is willing to accept our services in testing this law in the courts," the New York based American Civil Liberties Union announced soon after the anti-evolution statute passed.
