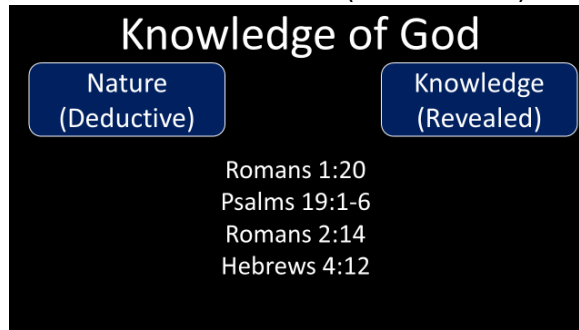


**Romans 1: Dualism of Knowledge**

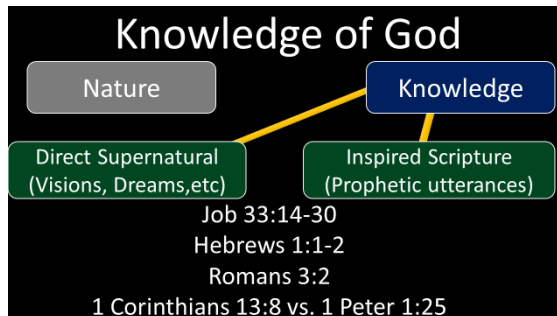
In romans 1 Paul makes the case that men should know God. He reveals something that we really have always known: the creation testifies that there is a God. In the book of Romans, he makes multiple cases for the superiority of certain types of knowledge of God. There are three comparisons made:

- Two ways God reveals Himself – Romans 1
- Two ways God reveals His will – Romans 2
- Two laws of men – Romans 8

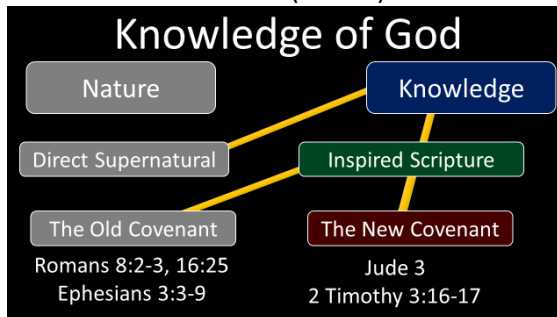
1. Two types of knowledge about God: what we deduce (from creation) and what God reveals directly



2. Two types of revelation from God: direct supernatural and the written word



3. Two types of written revelation: the old covenant (Moses) and the new covenant (Christ)



Conclusion: there is a distinct method of God revealing Himself to man. Ultimately, our revelation today, the completed Bible, is the superior to all other.
