- 1. What is Faith?
  - a. An evidence of something we do not witness Hebrews 11:1
  - b. A characteristic that pleases God Hebrews 11:6
- c. Faith is a characteristic we need to be saved John 3:36, Romans 1:17 Conclusion: Faith is an absolute confidence
- 2. It is not JUST believing
  - a. Many people believe things about God that are untrue Matthew 7:21-23
    - (1) Perhaps they believe traditions of men Matthew 15:8-9
    - (2) Perhaps they believe their own hearts Proverbs 28:26
    - (3) The result of believing something not by faith is a sin Romans 14:23
  - b. it is believing what God has said Romans 10:17
- (1) We must HEAR what God has said BEFORE we believe it Acts 18:8 Conclusion: Faith is an absolute confidence in what God has said
- 3. It is not JUST believing what God has said
  - a. Even the Devil believes in God James 2:19
  - b. it is acting on what God has said Hebrews 11
- c. It is doing the works that God has commanded of us James 2 Conclusion: Faith is an absolute confidence in what God has said and acting on it
- 4. What the Bible does NOT say about faith:
  - a. Man is saved by faith alone (James 2:24)
  - b. Faith comes from prayer (Romans 10:17)
  - c. Faith comes from miracles (Romans 10:17)
  - d. Faith is believing without evidence (Acts 17:11, John 5:39)
  - e. Faith is the opposite of reason (Isaiah 1:18
