

**Genesis 12: What is So Great About Abraham**

Abram (Later Abraham) is clearly someone important in the Bible. Matthew begins the genealogy of Jesus with Abraham. He is referenced nearly 70 times in the New Testament, only surpassed by Moses. His original name in the Bible is Abram (Exalted Father), but he will be known as Abraham, father of many. Ab is the first word in Hebrew (alphabetically).

1. Abraham is the model of Faith

a. Abraham is often referred to as the Father of All Faithful in the New Testament.

*Romans 9:6 But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For they are not all Israel who are descended from Israel; 7 nor are they all children because they are Abraham's descendants, but: "THROUGH ISAAC YOUR DESCENDANTS WILL BE NAMED." 8 That is, it is not the children of the flesh who are children of God, but the children of the promise are regarded as descendants.*

*Galatians 3:6 Even so Abraham BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS RECKONED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS. Therefore, be sure that it is those who are of faith who are sons of Abraham. The Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "ALL THE NATIONS WILL BE BLESSED IN YOU."*

b. Abraham was not the first man of faith, but the first to have OUR faith – things he would never see in His life, but instead he saw them by faith. His promises were to come after he was gone.

*Hebrews 11: 1 Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.*

*Hebrews 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.*

2. Abraham is the model of living as a sojourner/pilgrim

*Heb 11:8 By faith Abraham, when he was called, obeyed by going out to a place which he was to receive for an inheritance; and he went out, not knowing where he was going. 9 By faith he lived as an alien in the land of promise, as in a foreign land, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, fellow heirs of the same promise; 10 for he was looking for the city which has foundations, whose architect and builder is God.*

a. We are meant to live here in tents waiting for a reward apart from this life

*1Pe 1:17 If you address as Father the One who impartially judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves in fear during the time of your stay on earth;*

*1Pe 2:11 Beloved, I urge you as aliens and strangers to abstain from fleshly lusts which wage war against the soul.*

*2Co 5:1 For we know that if our earthly house, this tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.*

b. We are meant to be separated from the world

*2Co 6:14 Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness? 15 Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? 16 Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, "I WILL DWELL IN THEM AND WALK AMONG THEM; AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE. 17 "Therefore, COME OUT FROM THEIR MIDST AND BE SEPARATE," says the Lord. "AND DO NOT TOUCH WHAT IS UNCLEAN; And I will welcome you. 18 "And I will be a father to you, And you shall be sons and daughters to Me," Says the Lord Almighty.*

c. Even close friends and family

*Mt 10:37 "He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.*

3. Abraham is the model of obedience and seeking God

a. Abraham called on the Lord and was deemed righteous by faith

*Ro 4:3 For what does the Scripture say? "ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS."*

(1) We often point to the error of defining faith as just believing, but there is a righteousness in believing God

(2) In Gen 15:5-6, Abraham believed God when God told Him His plan, and God's word was enough to satisfy his worry

b. Abraham was a friend of God

*Jas 2:23 and the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "AND ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS RECKONED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS," and he was called the friend of God.*

(1) How is one a friend of God

*Jas 4:4 You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.*
