

7. The Canon of the Bible is shown to be perfect in that each inspired writer confirms another: Peter and Paul (II Peter 3:15 and I Corinthians 9:5), men of the Old Testament confirmed the New Testament (Hebrews 11, James 5), etc. Why is it that absolutely NO WHERE in the Old or New Testament is there mention of: *Nephi, Moroni, Mosiah, Alma, Helaman, Ether, or Mormon*? Did God forgot them in HIS inspired word?

8. Alma chapter one states Alma was made High Priest over the Lord's Church. Since then many *men* have held that office in the Mormon/LDS Church. How is this possible, when Hebrews chapter 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 (see 8:1) state that the ONE AND ONLY High Priest is Jesus Christ, and that a mere man CANNOT EVER be a fitting High Priest?

3:2-7. Do you or they meet these? What about the requirements in Titus 1:6-9?



Some Questions to ask our Mormon friends and visitors when we are offered a time to study.

commands for any Christian to study and show ourselves approved by God as being able to accurately handle his word. We should always be ready to give an answer for our faith (I Peter 3:15). An answer for Faith cannot be an emotion or feeling, because they can be wrong (I Timothy 4:2, Proverbs 14:12, Jeremiah 10:23). Since Faith comes from hearing the Word of God, an answer for Faith should do likewise.

1. If the Bible is inspired (as is taught in the Mormon/LDS Church), why do I need another book (the Book of Mormon) when the Bible says it is everything I need in II Timothy 3:16-17?

2. If another revelation was needed, why did Jude say that the Gospel had *once for all* been delivered in Jude 3? Why did Peter say that we have all things that we need pertaining to life and Godliness in II Peter 1:3?

3. Jesus said around AD 30 that he "will" (future tense) build his church (Matthew 16:18). In the Book of Mormon, Mosiah 18:17, the church of Christ is built 100 years before Jesus. Was Jesus wrong?

4. Joseph Smith claimed to be a prophet with another Gospel. What did Paul mean when he said that if anyone else, or even *an angel*, preaches another Gospel, let them be accursed in Galatians 1:8 and 9? What about John's condemnation for adding to or taking from the Bible in Revelation 22:18-19?

5. When a book is inspired by God, it is PERFECT. How can the Book of Mormon be inspired by God when it says of itself it is imperfect (1 Nephi 1:3, Mormon 9:31-33)?
